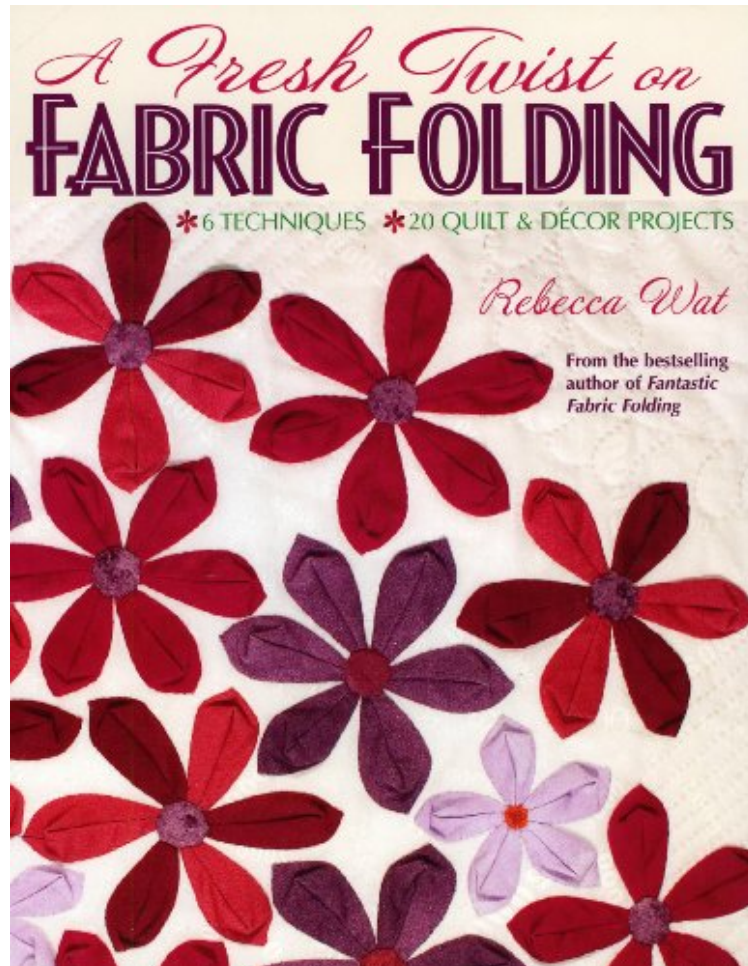

As with Ms Wat's other book, Fantastic Fabric Folding--which I also own--I am not as impressed with her choice of fabrics and colors or even with her designs--I am not a quilter, haven't the patience--as I am with her motifs. She includes here, as she has in her other book, the Inside-out Flowers (pp. 8-19), of which I am very fond, and an excellent chapter on Three Dimensional Petal Flowers (pp. 41-54) which I absolutely love. Her clear

and concise instructions for construction of her flowers is very helpful, with photos and verbal descriptions appropriately paired for those who may have a little trouble with visualizing three dimensional processes. Looking at the 1st book, it seems that you have to be intuitive to see how to do the next fold. I have a learning disability and need a better view of how to make the folds. Disappointed that it takes me several days of fussing and fighting to figure it out.
