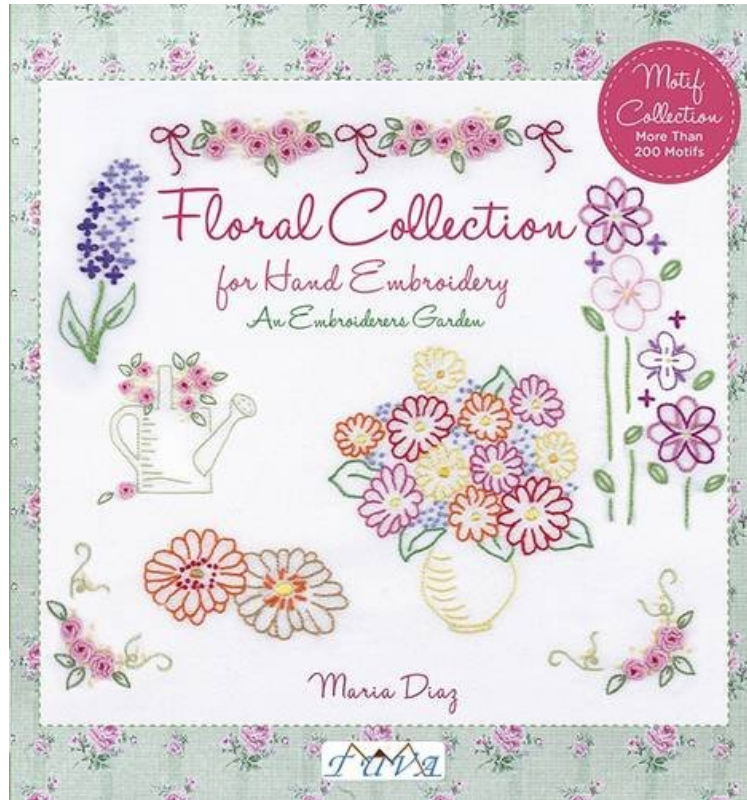

From fun motifs to pretty florals in a variety of sizes, the designs can be used to adorn anything from table cloths, towels, and cushions, to clothing. Each inspiring pattern has a color key and stitch suggestion indicated; beginners can simply backstitch the outline of the pattern to gain confidence, while experienced crafters can test their imagination by filling

the shapes with any number of stitches in their repertoire. All embroidery techniques used in this book are clearly explained, and drawings that show the type of the embroidery for each part of the pattern makes the book easy to follow.

"A sourcebook of floral designs for hand embroiderers. Use them to adorn any handmade project or give your latest shop bought items that handmade look. The book begins with all the materials and tools you will need and instructions for 19 embroidery stitches. The instructions give the colours in DMC thread for the motifs, but do not give the stitches used, although most are easy to see from the photographs of the finished motifs. It is a versatile book of fairly simple flower motifs and borders. Most of the designs are beginner level outline flowers with a few more challenging designs. Bears, birds, butterflies and birdhouses are included. There are over 200 motifs in all." yarnsandfabrics.co.uk
