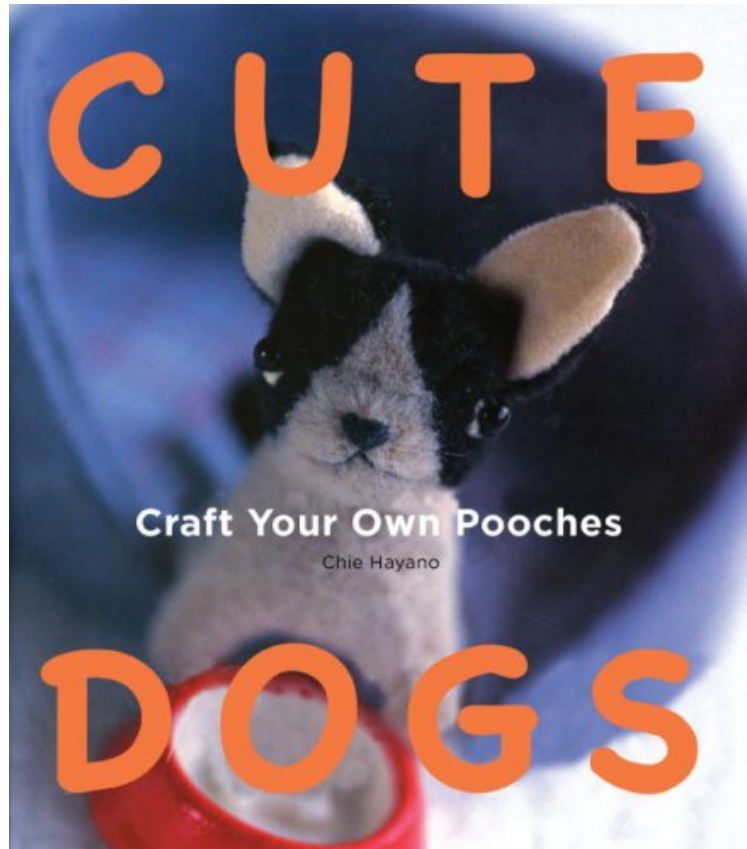

By pricklypear I can't recommend this book as highly as Tomomi Maeda's which is much better, but only has two dog patterns. Maeda's patterns call for felt and the seams are on the outside. No tedious turning inside out. This book wants you to use fake fur and turn it inside out! Hard to believe anyone could do that on this level of miniaturization. I tried enlarging the patterns as some people recommended, but the simplicity of the designs didn't translate as well in a larger size. So, I used felt, cut down some of the pattern pieces (mainly the gussets) and sewed them together on the outside. I highly recommend the Maeda book (Safari Animals, I think); it's a no-brainer. This one call for creativity.

By Brads Lizzie Oh my goodness! These are the cutest little stuffed puppy dogs ever!! I want a puppy, but can't have one, so I decided to make little stuffed toys of my own. I purchased this book along with a few others for help and ideas, since I am a newbie. Ok! So people say the puppies are tiny and they are not kidding!! The pattern literally is for a puppy something like 2 inches tall, so don't be surprised! The author shows lots of cute pictures and I haven't had difficulty finding the fabrics suggested. There are detailed instructions on how to put the

cover puppy together and the rest are variations on a theme. I will likely have to scan and increase the pattern size to be able to sew these, but I'm not complaining!! Maybe with enough practice I'll be able to sew well enough to make them in their tiny original size. If you are looking for adorable tiny puppy patterns, I do recommend this book.
