This book features artwork inspired by Sherrilyn Kenyon's paranormal romance Dark Hunters series. There are 24 illustrations of characters from Kenyon's stories, images on both sides of the page. The drawing style is like something you would see in a graphic novel, with thick lines and solid black shading. Each image is very strong, action-filled, and takes you immediately into the story. Even if you haven't read in this series, the pictures will inspire you. The paper is medium to thick weight. I used markers, gel pens, and alcohol markers for the example and the bleed-through was minimal, though you will lose the image on the back of the page. Colored pencils will not give you a problem. Also, this is a great book to practice your shading skills on fabrics and other items. The pages are perforated! Love that. Some of the characters included are Artemis, looking ever so goddess-like on her throne, Bane, who stands on a ship looking sexy but deadly, Savitar surfs through the waves, and Thorn will challenge you to learn how to properly

shade six-pack abs. (Actually, a lot of the men featured in the book will have you practicing your flesh-shading skills.) [But as a note: there is nothing vulgar in this book. Scenes include physically fit and muscular men and women and some may be holding weapons. There is no gratuitous violence. First it's extremely thin, and the pages are so finely detailed that it's hard for me ( the beginner) to figure out where to start and the high price of 10 bucks seems very steep for the few pages you get.
