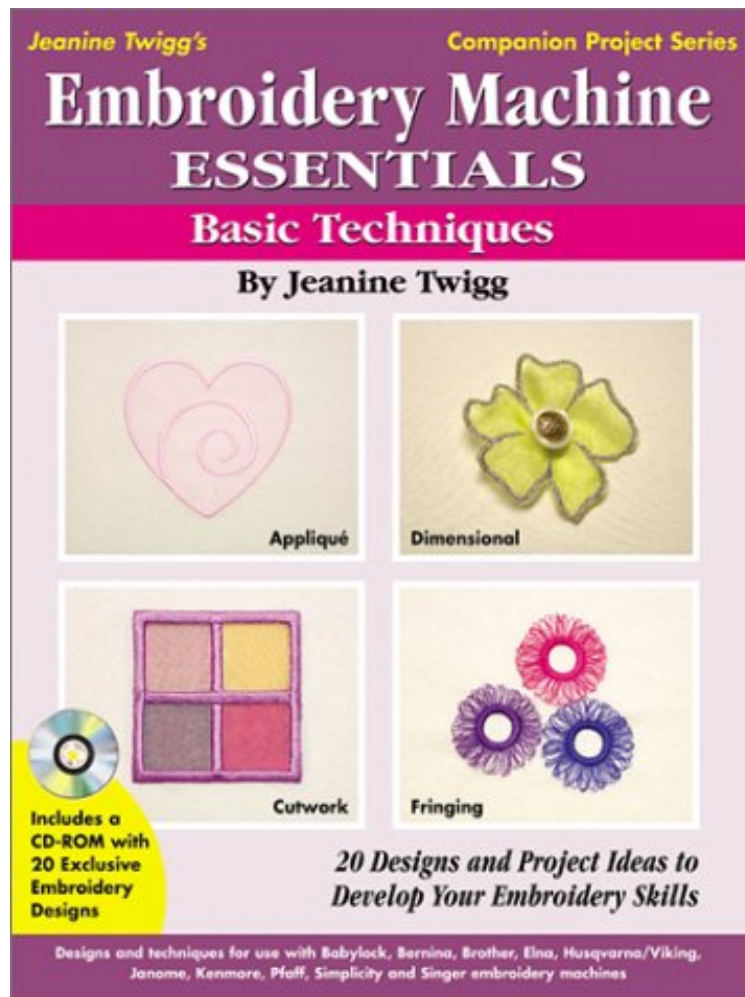

Just be aware that this book, while having good projects and nice designs included, really needs the parent book for the full experience.
