Not for beginners, but great for experienced stitchersBy Celtic GirlThis book is not technically a pattern book; it's more of a history of Dutch samplers. There is one project (the sampler shown on the cover) with a chart and thread colors given in the back of the book. This is a historical resource that explains some of the meaning behind the motifs and why particular subjects were used. Most of the book is in black and white, with a few color plates of historical samplers given. What I found most interesting is that many of the motifs (given on black-and-white charts throughout the book) currently appear in "new" primitive samplers today--so trees, houses, primitive figures, birds, etc. I would imagine many of the new designers in primitive cross-stitch use some of these old sampler books for inspiration. If you're an experienced cross-stitcher or needleworker, you'll have no problem pulling motifs out of the book to use for small projects.
