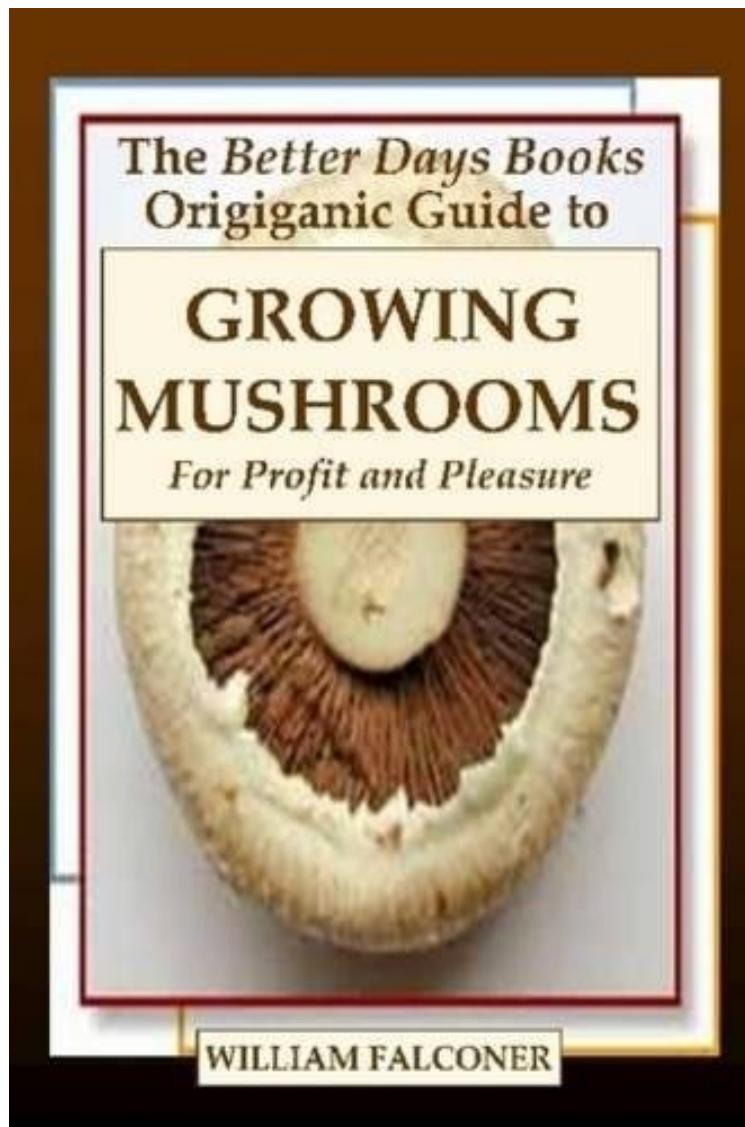

A simple statistic is that production, per square foot, is now 10 to 20 times that indicated for 1891 by Falconer. Unfortunately, for the amateur cultivator, there is really no good book available.
